GENERAL INFORMATION

Applications are online.* If you need assistance, contact claire@setc.org or call 336-272-3645. The deadline for applications is January 27, 2017. Acceptance is based on the order in which applications are received and approved. Follow the guidelines carefully when completing the application.

*All applicants must have access to an email address for notifications and the ability to pay with a credit card (Visa or MasterCard) unless a school check is being sent to pay application fees. If you or your school cannot gain access to a computer or credit card payment, let the SETC office know and we will help you.
